

HLTA candidate application checklist

To apply to gain HLTA status, all candidates must:

- have at least one years' experience working at HLTA level.
- be employed in a teaching and learning capacity in school for a minimum of 15 hours a week.
- be already working against the 33 HLTA standards.
- be competent in teaching 1:1 with experience of contributing to the planning of these lessons.
- be competent in teaching groups with experience of contributing to the planning of these lessons
- be competent in teaching whole class lessons, with experience of contributing to the planning of these lessons. ***These must be whole lessons with no teacher present and have experience of this on more than one occasion.***
- have, and able to provide evidence of, level 2 (equivalent to GCSE A*-C grade) qualifications in both English / literacy and Mathematics / numeracy.
This must be provided at the application stage.
- have a supporting statement from the Head Teacher to confirm candidate is currently meeting the HLTA standards in their current role and is ready to be formally assessed.
